About the University

Maharaja Suheldev University, Azamgarh was established by the Government of Uttar Pradesh in 2021 as a state university. It is named after the historic King Suheldev. The residential campus of the university is located in the Basgit area of Azamgarh city, while its affiliated colleges are spread across the districts of Azamgarh and Mau.

The university offers undergraduate, postgraduate, and research programs in various faculties, including Arts, Commerce, Science, Education, Engineering, Law, and Agriculture. A total of 468 colleges are affiliated with the university, comprising government, aided, and self-financed institutions.
